It has been a busy week and although there were no wow events, there has certainly been some wonderful work going on!



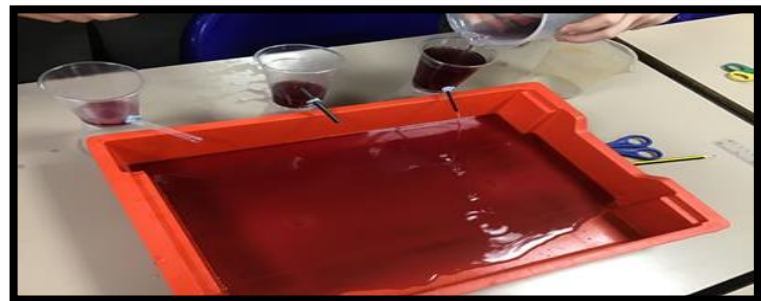
